What is and what is not.

What Is It? Behavior-specific praise is a positive statement directed toward a student or group of students that describes a desirable behavior in specific, observable, and measurable terms.

What it is not. A statement made at a student without directly effecting the behavior in specific terms or sarcastically.

What is Behavior Specific Praise?

- Behavior Specific Praise (BSP): Praise statements that include reference to the specific behavior for which the student is being recognized (Brophy, 1981; Sutherland, Wehby, & Copeland, 2000)
- Key Components
 - Praise statement must be linked to a behavior
 - Provide feedback specific to the behavior
 - Be sincere
 - Reflect skill level
 - Evaluate effectiveness
 - Praise effort not ability

General v. Specific



One study even had teachers wearing ear buds on one way radio communication (Ennis, R. P., Royer, D. J., Lane, K. L., & Dunlap, K. D. (2020).) I am not too sure how I would feel having someone telling me what to say while I am in the middle of a lecture

There are studies being done at every level of education from preschool (Gorton, K., Allday, R. A., Lane, J. D., & Ault, M. J. (2021)) to elementary (LaBrot, Z. C., Dufrene, B. A., Whipple, H., McCargo, M., & Pasqua, J. L. (2020)) and secondary (O'Handley, R. D., Olmi, D. J., Dufrene, (2020). The one key aspect of all these studies is how often it is being used and how important BSP is.
